



Posting Article Information in Rounds

1. Use PubMed to locate articles.
 - a. Select "Libraries" from "Quick Links" on MU main page.




- b. Select "Raynor Memorial Libraries" from Library page.




Posting Article Information in Rounds

Posting Article Information in Rounds

2. For each article

- a. Use PubMed search engine to find your article. Go to the main page for the article in PubMed.
