<b>Medical History:</b>
Lower back pain
<b>Dental History:</b>
Trauma to dentition while playing basketball. #8 missing due to trauma, #9 reimplanted, root canal treated and crowned, #2 permanent crown fell off, #31 extracted a long time ago and has all 4 wisdom teeth.
<b>Radiographic Findings:</b>
Periapical Apical Radiolucency (PARL) noted at the apex of #26. #9 and #19 root canal treated.
<b>Clinical Findings:</b>
Existing restorations: 14 O amalgam, 15 O amalgam, 18 O amalgam, 30 O resin, 9 ACC, and 19 PFM. Missing teeth: 8 and 31 Incipient caries: 1 O, 3 OL, 15 L, 16 O, 32 O Primary caries: 18 D, 14 L, 17 O, 30 O Abrasion: all incisal edges of 7, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27
<b>Periodontal Findings:</b>
Deep pockets depths and notable CAL around all 4 wisdom teeth and #9. Moderate supragingival calculus and slight subgingival calculus.
<b>Periodontal Diagnosis:</b>
Stage II – Early Chronic Periodontitis
<b>Problem List:</b>
Missing front tooth (#8) and crown fell off on #2. Primary caries on a few teeth. Moderate plaque and localized deep pocket depths. PARL on #26.
<b>Other:</b>
Submitted an internal referral for Oral Radiology. Obtained professional advice and got the referral form approved and case looked at by Dr. Demirturk. Patient has decided to seek private practice for his front tooth but wants Marquette to take care of all other dental needs.

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
