Patient presented with the chief complaint of getting a crown on #12. The previous crown had fallen off years ago and the patient had used the prep as a functioning tooth. Patient also presented with a fractured bridge from teeth 18 to 20 and indicated that she would like that fixed too. We discussed in depth if it would be better to extract and place implants in the place of teeth 18 and 20 or use the natural teeth to complete elective endo, place posts, build up cores, and then place a bridge. In the end, we discovered that it would be more beneficial long term to utilize the healthy teeth present rather than extract them and place implants.

Clinical Findings:
Reduced ferrule amount on #12 <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Crown lengthening was indicated- Missing bridge from #18-20<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Endo, post, core, bridge is indicated- Recurrent Caries on #13 MOD
Periodontal Findings:
All periodontal findings were within normal limits. There was reduced ferrule available on #12, so crown lengthening had to be completed in order to prep for new crown.

Periodontal Health, 6 month recalls indicated
