Medical Conditions: High blood pressure, Arrhythmia (irregular heart beat), Asthma, Emphysema/COPD, Sleep apnea, Snoring, Type 2 Diabetes, Frequent urination, Feelings of anxiety, Osteoarthritis, Vision problems, Hearing impairment
